MPD 3 (1abs)

- 1 Clarke's Tigerrock I'm Your Man. 7 month old baby, he is mature for his age presenting a lovely outline. Compact with plenty of bone and substance. Good welsh head and soft expression. Well angulated with width in his second thigh, well let down hocks and tight feet. Balanced on the move. BPD.
- 2 Jackson's Tigerrock Gardez La Foi NAF TAF. Litter brother to the winner so has a lot of his brother's attributes. He is going through his interim stage so is not as mature. Having said that he has a lovely head and expression. Good reach of neck and lay of shoulder. A bit "bum high" at the moment and moved well when settled. One to watch.

- 1 Clarke's Tigerrock Magic Roundabout. It was a close run decision between these two half brothers but I just preferred the head of the winner with his depth of muzzle and stop. Short coupled and nicely angulated with good tailset and feet. Balanced on the move.

eye, good reach of neck with well laid shoulders, a strong body and well muscled and angulated rear end. Well let down hocks and tight feet. He is compact and balanced both standing and on the move.

- 1 Knowles' Menstonia Minstrel JW. A really lovely dog from this kennel. Such a very typical welsh with a masculine head and soft expression. Good reach of neck, well laid shoulder and good length of upper arm. Correct topline which he held on the move. Well ribbed with depth of brisket and a strong well angulated rear end. Super feet. I was delighted to award him the DCC and to see him go BIS under the referee.
- 2 Graham's Nyliram Let's Twist Again JW. Another very nice dog with much to offer, this boy pished hard for top spot. He has a pleasing head with a strong neck and is well angulated at both shoulder and stifle. Not quite the depth of brisket as the winner which made him appear longer cast which actually he was not. Moved out well with drive.

L 2(1abs)

1 Bennett's Helgen Romeo the Lover for Flyboron. On his own but a worthy winner. He has a good welsh head with depth of muzzle and presented a pleasing outline. Good lay of shoulder and length of upper arm with nicely angulated stifle. Well let down hocks, good tailset and tight feet.

O 8(1abs)

- 1 Ritchie & Butler's Slapestones Diamond Mine JW. I was spoilt for choice in this class and placings could well change another day. This boy has a lovely head and alert expression, so well proportioned with a good neck and well laid shoulder, well sprung ribs and a typical topline. Correct bend of stifle and in good hard condition. Moved out well with drive. RCC
- 2 Graham's Sh Ch Taimeres Twister round Nyliram JW ShCM. A lot of the attributes to the winner apply to this dog as well. Another very typical welsh with a pleasing head and depth of muzzle. He has plenty of bone and substance and presents a balanced picture with good angulation front and back. Well let down hocks and super feet. A bit heavier overall than the winner. Moved out well.
- 3 Clarke's Sh Ch Ferndel High Fidelity with Tigerrock ShCM Sh Cex

SB 4(1abs)

- 1 Green's Eurion Jasper. A compact well balanced dog standing and on the move. He has a pleasing head with a good reach of neck. Well laid shoulders with a good upper arm. Well sprung ribs and correct rise over loin. Strong back end providing the drive to move really well.
