The North of England Welsh Springer Spaniel Club held an open show at Thorpe Willoughby where **BIS was Sh Ch Ferndel Justin Time**; RBIS Sh Ch Ferndel Comander at Bethersden; BP Ferndel Peanut Butter at Ravensworth; & BV Bushwacker Thriller.

VD (5) 1 Cocking & Barnaby's Bushwacker Thriller, Masculine headed dog, soundly constructed with ample bone. Moved well on nice tight feet and certainly not showing his age. BVIS; 2 Murray's Slapstone Mars at Priestbeck, Slightly finer all through than 1 but still masculine with pleasing head, well put together with sufficient bone, well set neat tail and tight feet. Beginning to show his age; 3 Clarke's Jeavart Different Strokes by Tigerrock. MPD (0). PD (3) 1 Riley's Ferndel Peanut Butter at Ravensworth, well grown puppy who shouts 'dog'. Pleasing angulation fore and aft with ample bone and in beautiful condition. Slightly loose on the move as one would expect at this age. BPIS: 2 Harrison's Glenbrows Legacy, finer than 1 with pleasing head, good eye shape and colour. Balanced and well made body just needs to 'drop', well presented and handled; 3 Riley's Ferndel Buttermint at Ravensworth. JD (3) 1 F Peanut Butter at R; 2 G Legacy; 3 F Buttermint at R. YD (3) 1 Sutherland's Jacranella Solo, full of breed type, masculine but not over done in anyway, soft expression, with good eye shape and colour, chiselling below the eyes. Good fore chest and spring of rib with pleasing angulation fore and aft. The best is yet to come; 2 Brown's Bowdonia Ozzie, finer than 1 with well proportioned head, good length of neck. Moderate angulation all through, a sound free mover on tight feet; 3 Clark & Casey's Ferndel High Fidelity with Tigerrock. ND (4) 1 F Peanut Butter at R; 2 G Legacy; 3 F Buttermint at R. **GD** (1) Yacoub & Samsel's Laithmoor's Marek, very typical lad, lovely head, good eye shape and colour. Soundly constructed with good length of neck and ample bone, shown in full coat he was giving his owner a hard time today. PGD (1) 1 Clarke's Tigerrock Bat Out Of Hell, medium sized chap, would prefer a stronger head, good length of neck and balanced, moved at one with handler showing animation a real showman. LD (4) 1 Murray's Lyndfil Simba from Priestbeck, nicely sized, pleasing head with correctly shaped eye and colour, soft expression. Good length of neck into well laid shoulder, strong rear. Quality bone and well set tail. I liked him very much; 2 Frost's Cochnaid's Cartier Topaz, from a smaller mould but close to 1. Typical head with soft expression, good length of neck and correct angles fore and aft. Well presented and handled, a sound mover; 3 Tew's Pamicks Believe You Can. **OD** (6) I really was spoilt for choice in this class, no doubt the exhibits have all changed places many times. 1 Douglas' Sh Ch Ferndel Justin Time, correctly proportioned head with good depth of muzzle, well shaped eve of correct colour giving a soft expression. Ample length of neck into well laid shoulder soundly constructed and balanced with good turn of stifle. Quality bone, he moved on tight feet, in full coat, he is the finished article, delighted to award him BIS; 2 Tolladay's Sh Ch Ferndel Comander of Bethersden, from a similar mould to 1, handsome head with soft expression, good length of neck, balanced and correct angles fore and aft. Ample bone, well presented and handled just lacking the coat of 1 today. RBIS; 3 Cocking & Barnaby's Sh Ch Bushwacker Captain Courageous of Ruskinite. SBD (2) 1 L Marek; B Ozzie. WTD (0).

VB (5) 1 Sutherland's Ch Julita Rezanella of Jacranella, workman like and a worthy ch, very well made all through without any frills. A sound and positive mover; 2 Philipson's Menstonia Memories Past, pretty head with correct eye shape and colour, good pigment. Balanced with quality bone and neat feet not quite the movement of 1; 3 Clarke's Tiggerrock Eye Of The Tiger. MPB (1) 1 Tew's Pamicks Field Of Dreams, well grown 7 month old puppy. Appealing head with good length of neck and soundly constructed. Quality bone and tight feet she movement was very together for her age. PB (3) 1 Dyer's Benton Small Talk among Tylwyth, pretty bitch with lovely head and correctly shaped eve. Good length of neck into soundly constructed front. Good spring of rib and pleasing turn of stifle, quality bone moved well on tight feet. Perhaps lucky some coat today but hiding nothing; 2 Ritchie's Sarabande Eternity at Slapestones, feminine headed bitch with lovely proportions. Finer all through, soundly made with tight feet and in good condition; 3 Harrison's Glenbrows Liberty. IB (5) 1 Dyer's Islanza Royale among Tylwyth, correctly proportioned head with good depth of muzzle and soft expression. Soundly constructed front, balanced with quality bone, well set tail and tight feet a sound and free mover; 2 S Eternity at S; 3 G Liberty. YB (7) 1 Sutherland's Jacranella Symphony, typical head with soft expression and so full of breed type, a lovely shape standing. Well made with good fore chest, quality bone and ample turn of stifle. Muscled and a sound moved; 2 Tolladay's Ferndel High Society to Bethersden, finer bitch from a more elegant mould and less mature than 1. Pretty head with kind expression, good length of neck, well made and balanced with correct tail carriage she was well presented and handled; 3 Tain's Taimere's Two Step. NB (3) 1 S Eternity at S; 2 Sutherland's Jacranella Sonata, like her siblings this bitch is full of breed type presenting a lovely shape standing with pretty head and good length of neck. Balanced and beautifully turned out; 3 Clark & Casey's Tigerrock And Inmas Carless Whispers Candy. GB (4) 1 Sutherland's Jacranella Serenade, broken coated with feminine head and soft expression. Excelling type she is soundly made, muscled and moved soundly. Well handled and presented; 2 Yacoub's Laithmoor's Kasya, another typical bitch of correct size with nicely proportioned head with soft expression. Good length of neck into well laid shoulders soundly constructed with quality bone and moved well on tight feet; 3 Clark & Casey's Tigerrock Perfect Ten. **PGB** (3) 1 Backhouse's Glenbrows Truth about Aindrea. showy bitch in full coat and very typical of her breeding, beautiful head with correct eye shape and colour. Lovely length of neck into well laid shoulders, good fore chest and well put together. Would prefer tighter feet but went well; 2 T Perfect Ten, smaller finer bitch presenting a lovely outline standing, pretty head and moderate angulation with well set tail. Moved well on tight feet. LB (3) 1 Tain's Taimere's Takes The Biscuit, impressive standing with pretty head and soft expression. Good length of neck into well laid shoulders. Well balanced and in good coat with pleasing profile movement. RBB; 2 Frost's Cochnaid's Cartier Diamond, a very pretty and typy smaller bitch presenting a balanced picture. Happy and sound mover, well presented and handled. **OB** (2) 1 Ritchie's Sh Ch Slapestones Mouna, medium sized bitch with pleasing head, good depth of muzzle, ample neck into well laid shoulders. Soundly made as you would expect from this kennel with quality bone and neat feet. Shown in her best clothes with a well set short tail. BB. SBB (1) L Kasya. WTB (1) A.
